lesser truths of our Faith.

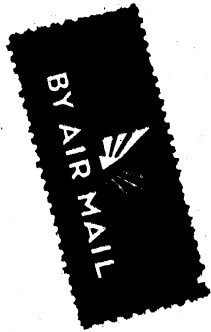
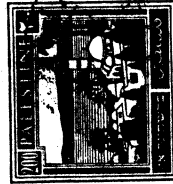
He assures you of his
