Mrs. Dahl and I respectively request the privilege of a pilgrimage, starting sometime between May 9 and May 15, 1960. If there is a choice, the earlier dates would be preferred. If it is not possible at this time, could you please tell us the earliest date after this time that would be open.

In addition to ourselves, we would like to bring our four boys, Keith, Arthur, Roger and Gregory. At the time of the pilgrimage their ages would be approximately $19\frac{1}{2}$, $17\frac{1}{2}$, almost 14 and almost 12. If it is not possible to accomodate them in the Pilgrim House, we could have them stay at a hotel in Haifa. But we think it would be an invaluable experience for them to visit the Holy Shrines and to meet you.

This is the culmination of a hope we have had for many years, and is being arranged only with great difficulty as far as my business is concerned. However, we think it will be so valuable for the boys as well as ourselves to make the pilgrimage, as well as see something of Europe, and from many points of view this is a good time to make this step. We plan to come over after the National Convention.
